EXAM SYLLABUS

CONTENTS

- **Multiple-choice:** three-option multiple-choice items: signs and messages, postcards, notes, e-mails, labels, etc. Students have to identify which type of short text is and choose from options A, B or C the one which talks about the text. Students will be tested on their ability to find key words and understand short texts.
- **Matching:** five items in the form of descriptions of people to match to eight short adapted – authentic texts. Students should be able to identify what each person needs and choose the correct option for each. Students will develop the ability to understand short texts, find key words and understand paraphrasing.
- **True / False items:** ten items with an adapted - authentic long text. Students have to read a long text and establish if the sentences from 11-20 are Right or Wrong.
- **Multiple-choice:** four-option multiple-choice items: five items with an adapted authentic long text. Students have to read a long text and answer 5 multiple-choice questions about the text in general. Students will develop the ability to comprehend a text as a whole.
- **Multiple-choice:** four-option multiple-choice cloze: ten items, plus an integrated example, with an adapted, authentic text drawn from a variety of sources. The text is of a factual or narrative nature. Students have to complete the blank spaces in the text choosing from options A-D. Students will be tested on their knowledge of vocabulary and sentence structure.
